

Isobel will now be managing the range of services offered by UP including check-ins, six times talk times and well-being groups. Isobel will also manage the different therapists who offer one-to-one support for children who may need additional input to help them manage a difficult period in their life. Later, in the Summer Term, we will also be gaining some valuable support from a speech and language therapist from UP working in the school to further support our children.

Isobel has been getting to know the children and staff this week, as well as meeting parents on the gate. I know you will join me in welcoming Isobel to the New End staff team.

Without NESA continuing to fund this project, New End would not be in the same position to offer such valuable support for our community's mental health and well being, supporting us through periods of challenge and change. Thank you!

School gates open at 8.50am.


School starts at 8.55am.


