Parent-Teacher Meetings

This term's opportunity to meet the teacher and discuss how well your child has settled into their new class will be similar to last year. In order to reduce risk we will operate a controlled-entry system whereby Year Group teachers will be available from 3.50pm - 7.30pm for 10 minute slots on

Tuesday, 22nd October

Bookings will open on Tuesday, 15th October at 8.15am. In order to be allocated a slot with the appropriate teacher, please go via your Scopay account and ensure you book <u>by 2pm Friday, 18th October.</u> If you do not have a Scopay account, please contact the school office for an online code.

On the evening of your allocated slot, all access to the building will be via the Main Gate in Streatley Place. We ask that you arrive **5 minutes** before your time in order to be admitted. The meetings will be held in your child's classroom. Adhering strictly to timings is important so that we can regulate the flow of parents in and out of the building. **This is particularly important with the current building works.**

New End Primary School will be celebrating Harvest Festival next week. We will be talking about Harvest in our Wednesday assemblies and asking families to make their donations.

Star Awards

As a school we enjoy celebrating the achievements of New End children.

During Friday celebration assemblies, staff hand out certificates to those children who have achieved something special during the week. Certificates are also awarded for projects completed or for representing the school at a sporting or other event.

Since February 2009 we have been recording the names of children who receive either a class or headteacher certificate or who represent New End at a sporting or other event.

Each half term we award those children whose names have been recorded five times with a New End star. We ask parents and carers to attend these assemblies to share in their child's achievements.

During these assemblies, children who have achieved a multiple of 5 also receive a medal or trophy to mark their achievement.

The first star assemblies will be held on Friday, 8th November with children receiving their letters during the final week before half term.

There have been <u>27 lates</u> last week (1 less than the week before) involving <u>17 children</u> (3 less than the week before) throughout the school.

Children who are late will miss important learning time. Children who are late disrupt teachers' teaching and other children's learning!


