Congratulations 1K and 5P – 100% attendance last week!

Well done RF, 1D, 2S, 3J, 3P, 4M, 4W, 5M, 5P and 6S – the classes with no unauthorised absence last week!

Well done 4W – the only class with everyone in school on time last week!

Attendance across the school last week is 98.47%, with an unauthorised absence level of 0.07%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 95.77% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.37%.

As always, if children are ill, they must remain at home. Please ensure that you contact the school office to explain any absence to ensure that it is authorised.

REMEMBER....

School gates open at 8.50am. School starts at 8.55am.

There have been **49 lates** the week before half term (22 more than last week) involving **34 children** (15 more than last week) throughout the school. An awful week for punctuality!

Being late adds up to loss of learning:

- * 5 minutes late every day adds up to 3 days lost each year
- * 10 minutes late every day adds up to 6 days lost each year
- * 15 minutes late every day adds up to 10 days lost each year
- * 20 minutes late every day adds up to 13 days lost each year
- * 30 minutes late every day adds up to 19 days lost each year

Children who are late will miss important learning time. Children who are late disrupt teachers' teaching and other children's learning!

Please respect others and be in school on time.
