Attendance across the school last week is 93.27%, with an unauthorised absence level of 0.25%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 95.79% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.26%.

Parents whose children have had low attendance in the Autumn Term will be receiving a letter at the start of the new year which will include information about how the school will be monitoring this moving into the Spring Term.

There have been <u>11 lates</u> last week (17 less than the week before) involving <u>7 children</u> (13 less than the week before) throughout the school. Let's keep this up into 2025!!
