

In 2024-2025 financial year we are using the Sports Premium Funding to:

- Ensure the continuing employment of two experienced Sports Coaches for 1½ days a week. (This employment cost the school approximately £30K in the 2024-2025 financial year. The Sports Premium Funding was £18 750.) These coaches provide specialist input for children in Nursery to Year Six for an hour each week.

We continue to focus on providing a really inclusive PE curriculum, offering a wide (and changing) range of sports for the children to participate in, helping children to understand the importance of an active lifestyle (and associated health benefits) and increasing overall participation in borough wide events. Children learn a range of traditional team sports such as hockey and basketball. We monitor and track the aerobic fitness levels of our children through regular activities such as the Bleep Test to assess multi-stage fitness.

This year the school has entered teams (Girls, Boys and Mixed Teams depending on the competition) into Camden's Y5/6 football tournament, the cross country gala and the swimming meet. Year 2 to Year 6 children received additional cricket training through "Ray Tudor Academy" for an hour session over a half term.

New End has:

- Finished 8th in the Camden Cross Country Competition
- Finished 3rd place in the Camden Football Fair Play League
- Finished 7th place in both the Girls and Boys' Football competition

The impact of this funding, both from the school initially and then combined with the government funding more recently, has been:

- Specialist input for all children from Nursery to Year Six each week.
- Continued success in local authority sporting competitions.
- The school continues to have positive results in the Reception and Year 6 height and measurement surveys.
- This provision predated the Sports Premium Funding so has enabled the school to target other areas.
