<u>Attendance and Punctuality – Autumn and Spring Terms</u>

Parents and carers may be aware of the continuing government drive on getting children into school.

The most recent attendance national figures were published this week. These run from 1st September until Friday, 4th April. So comparing our figures for the same period...

Attendance for the Autumn and Spring terms at New End was 95.44% (ar improvement from 95.21% in the Autumn term alone.)

This compares to the national attendance figure for primary schools of 94.8%.

Unauthorised absence level for the Autumn term at New End was of 0.36% (which is higher than the 0.28% in the Autumn Term.)

This compares to the national unauthorised absence figure for primary schools of 1.3%.

This shows that we have maintained the positive start we have made again this year when compared to the national figures. Let's try to keep this up!!

REMEMBER....

Being in school is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, and wider development. Evidence shows that the students with the highest attendance throughout their time in school gain the best GCSE and A Level results.
