School gates open at 8.50am. School starts at 8.55am.


There have been **20 lates** the week before half term (1 less than last week) involving **15 children** (1 less than last week) throughout the school. Let's keep these improvements going!

Secondary Transfer Meetings

A parents' meeting about secondary schools is being held on Thursday, 19th June at 6pm and repeated on Friday, 20th June at 9.15am.

These meetings are particularly important to the current Year Five parents and carers who will need to make their choices in October 2025. Parents of children in Year 3 and 4 who will have to make decisions in the next year or two may also find it useful to attend. It is never too early to start considering your options or to be aware of the process of applying!

Please be aware that applications do not have to be finalised until the end of October 2025.

However, parents wishing to apply for state funded selective secondary schools such as QE Boys and Henrietta Barnett, need to apply before the end of this term. Dates will be provided at the meeting.
