## **Sports Day**

## **Transport**

Children will be walking with their class to and from the venue. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time so that classes leave straight after register.

## **Lunches**

Reception, Year 1 and 2: Children will arrive back at school before lunch and will eat their regular school lunch.

Years 3, 4, 5 and 6: Children will be at the venue all day and are encouraged to bring a **packed lunch**.

Please make sure that your child has snacks and a water bottle packed in their bag.

## Clothing

Children can wear a t-shirt that is the colour of their sporting house or their school PE t-shirt.

All children should wear regular school PE kit (e.g. shorts, jumper, trainers), sunscreen and a hat. In case of inclement weather, children should also bring a raincoat or mac.

House colours: Burgh – blue, Fenton – red, Keats – yellow and Kenwood – green. (Teachers will remind children)

## **Spectators**

Parents/Carers will have access to the spectator hill and are welcome to watch all races and field events.

Please make sure you leave the starting and finishing line areas clear as there is often congestion in these areas which makes it difficult for those starting the races and those handing out places at the finish.

<u>Spectators must stay on the hill at all times.</u> It makes it incredibly difficult for staff and unfair on other parents and their children when individual parent and carers cross the track.

<u>Please remember that permission is required for filming students that are not your own.</u>
