	Three parents had applied, and an election was being held.			
6.	GOVERNORS MONITORING, DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING			
	JC, HN and CL had all attended the Camden Governors conference and would	JC/HN/CL		
	report back at the next meeting.			
	HA had done safeguarding and information training at work.			
7.	REPORT FROM FINANCE COMMITTEE			
	Governors agreed to the recommendation from Finance Committee to			
	adopt the budget for 2025-2026 as presented by NH, noting that it was a			
	prudent, balanced budget with a carry forward in line with Camden's recommendations,			
	Governors noted that the main risk was that there might be a higher bill for			
	agency cover than budgeted for.			
	The budget included allocated funds that would cover the risk that the			
	Government might not fund the costs of staff pay rises in 2025/06 (including			
	pension and NI contributions) above 3%. The budget was based on a probable 3% for no- teaching staff and 5% for teaching staff.			
	It also included funding to cover additional free school meal costs not covered			
	by the mayor in 2024/5.			
	Governors recognised that these two risks were also opportunities – if the			
	Government did fund pay rises in full and if the mayor did provide additional			
	funds for free school meals, then the school's carry over would rise and some could be used elsewhere.			
	AS as staff governor had no additional comments.
