May Day Ball Discos

The **Nursery and Reception disco** will be held during the school day. Children in Nursery and Reception can wear their party clothes for the day. Children will receive a drink and a treat. No charge will be made for these tickets although any donations towards the charity will be gratefully received.

Tickets for the Years 1, 2 and 3 disco will be sold on Tuesday 17th May from 8.30 am.

Tickets for the Years 4, 5 and 6 disco will be sold on Thursday 19th May from 8.30 am.

Tickets will cost £3.00.

Parents will need to queue up on the relevant days and pay for their own child/children's tickets only. Children in Key Stage Two who normally come to school by themselves may queue for their own ticket.

Due to health and safety, there will be a maximum of 100 children per disco.

TIME: Nursery and Reception disco - 2.00pm - 3pm

Years 1, 2 and 3 disco - 4.30 pm to 5.30 pm

COST: Tickets will cost £3.00 which will include entry and all drinks and treats. We will not be selling additional sweets and drinks mainly because the younger children often lose their money and we also want to ensure that the older children don't go over the top with their sugar intake!
