Attendance across the school last week was **96.43%**, with an unauthorised absence level of **0.5%**. Attendance to date this year is **94.70%**, with an unauthorised absence level of **0.42%**.

An interesting piece of information...If children are to achieve their potential, good attendance and punctuality are critical. The link between attendance and achievement is well documented. Figures from the DFE demonstrate this very clearly. Its most recent study on this matter found that, in general, the higher the percentage of sessions missed across the key stage, the lower the likely level of attainment at the end of KS2. In particular, pupils with no absence are 1.6 times more likely to achieve national expectation or above, and 4.7 times more likely to achieve above national expectations, than pupils that missed 15-20 per cent of all sessions.
