

In 2017-2018 used the Sports Premium Funding to:

- Ensure the continuing employment of two experienced Sports Coaches for 1½ days a week and one lunchtime coach. (This employment cost the school approximately £20 375 in the 2017-2018 financial year . The Sports Premium Funding was £15 394.) These coaches provide specialist input for children in Nursery to Year Six for an hour each week.

We are focused on providing a really inclusive PE curriculum, offering a wide (and changing) range of sports for the children to participate in, helping children to understand the importance of an active lifestyle (and associated health benefits) and increasing overall participation in borough wide events. Children learn a range of traditional team sports such as hockey and basketball. We monitor and track the aerobic fitness levels of our children through regular activities such as the Bleep Test to assess multi-stage fitness.

In 2017-2018 we entered teams (Girls, Boys and Mixed Teams depending on the competition) into Camden's Y5/6 football tournaments, indoor athletics and the cross country gala. We participated in Camden's Y3/4 football tournaments, Y5/6 rounders tournament, Y5/6 cricket tournament, Swimming Gala, and Outdoor Athletics tournament . Our two Sports Day were held in the Summer Term (July). The Early Years Sports Day was held in school whilst the Years One to Six sports day was a traditional day of activities and races on Hampstead Heath.

We usually finish in the top third of events and our most able children are given a chance to shine. However we aim to improve the overall health and well being of all our children and encourage them to join in all school based sporting activities. We also have training and compete in an inclusive cricket tournament at Lords each year.

This year New End:

- Finished 8<sup>th</sup> in the Camden Cross Country Competition
- Won the Camden Boys' Football League
- Boys' Football Team represented Camden in the London Youth Games
- Finished in 6<sup>th</sup> place in the Camden Girls' Football League
- Runners up in the Boys' Camden Cricket Tournament
- Finished in 6<sup>th</sup> place in the Camden Girls' Cricket Tournament
- Girls' Cricket Team represented Camden in the London Youth Games
- Participated in the Inclusive Cricket Tournament at Lords

The impact of this funding, both from the school initially and then combined with the government funding more recently, has been:

- Specialist input for all children from Nursery to Year Six each week.
- Continued success in local authority sporting competitions.
- This provision predated the Sports Premium Funding so has enabled the school to target other areas.
