

In 2018-2019 we are using the Sports Premium Funding to:

- Ensure the continuing employment of two experienced Sports Coaches for 1½ days a week and one lunchtime coach. (This employment cost the school approximately £21 330 in the 2018-2019 financial year. The Sports Premium Funding was £19 333.) These coaches provide specialist input for children in Nursery to Year Six for an hour each week.

We are focused on providing a really inclusive PE curriculum, offering a wide (and changing) range of sports for the children to participate in, helping children to understand the importance of an active lifestyle (and associated health benefits) and increasing overall participation in borough wide events. Children learn a range of traditional team sports such as hockey and basketball. We monitor and track the aerobic fitness levels of our children through regular activities such as the Bleep Test to assess multi-stage fitness.

So far this year we have entered teams (Girls, Boys and Mixed Teams depending on the competition) into Camden's Y5/6 football tournaments, Y5/6 indoor cricket tournament, and the cross country gala. Later in the year we will be participating in Camden's Y3/4 football tournaments, Y5/6 rounders tournament, Lords cricket tournament, Swimming Gala, and Outdoor Athletics tournament. Our two Sports Day will be held in the Summer Term.

We usually finish in the top third of events and our most able children are given a chance to shine. However we aim to improve the overall health and well being of all our children and encourage them to join in all school based sporting activities. We also have training and compete in an inclusive cricket tournament at Lords each year.

So far this year New End has:

- Finished 8th in the Camden Cross Country Competition
- Finished 3rd place in the Camden Football Fair Play League
- Finished 7th place in both the Girls and Boys' Football competition

The impact of this funding, both from the school initially and then combined with the government funding more recently, has been:

- Specialist input for all children from Nursery to Year Six each week.
- Continued success in local authority sporting competitions.
- This provision predated the Sports Premium Funding so has enabled the school to target other areas.
