Attendance across the school last week was 95.48%, with an unauthorised absence level of 0.87%. Parents and carers are reminded that if you do not contact the office to give a reason for your child's absence, it is recorded as unauthorised.

Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 95.99% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.59%. It is good to see this improving but we all need to continue to work together to improve these figures! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.

There were 46 lates last week (13 less than the week before) involving 36 children (12 less than the week before) throughout the school. Improvement needed!

### Secondary Transfer

Year Six parents and carers are reminded that applications for secondary school for September 2019 need to be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019. Camden have been in touch to remind you of the applications as there are few completed forms for children at New End.

Remember that a separate application form is required for Voluntary Aided Schools (e.g.: Church or Selective State schools). Parents must collect these directly from the school.
