Parent-Teacher Meetings – A REMINDER

Parent-Teacher meetings will take place next week (the week beginning 3rd February) for Year Six parents. **Bookings are live** for Year Six parents and carers **but only until 12 noon, TOMORROW, Friday, 31st January.** Late bookings then need to be made via the school office if places are available.

Parent-Teacher meetings will take place the week beginning 10th February for Nursery to Year Five parents. **Bookings are live** for all other parents and carers. All other parents will be able to sign up via Tucasi **until 12 noon, Friday, 7th February.** Late bookings then need to be made via the school office if places are available.

Parents will be able to sign up via Tucasi to arrange a meeting with your child's class teacher. You use the same log in as the On-Line Payment Account. Once you have logged in it will show your child/ren's name(s) and times available. Once you make the booking you will receive an email confirming the time. You will be able to change times up until the day before if there are places available.

Parents who do not have access to a Tucasi account or find it difficult can come into the office and we will support you with your booking.

No class had 100% attendance last week!

Well done RL - everyone in school on time every day last week!

Attendance across the school last week was 94.36%, with an unauthorised absence level of 0.52%. Parents and carers are reminded that if you do not contact the office to give a reason for your child's absence, it is recorded as unauthorised.

Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 94.50% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.96%. It is good to see this improving but we all need to continue to work together to improve these figures! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.

There were 47 lates last week (8 more than the week before) involving 33 children (1 less than the week before) throughout the school. Improvement definitely still needed!

A good education gives a child the best possible start in life. We must ensure that all our pupils have an equal chance to make good use of the education that the school offers by providing a positive and encouraging atmosphere. To achieve this it is important that each child attends school regularly and punctually. When a child does not attend school regularly and on time they will have difficulty keeping up with their work and will therefore underachieve.

It is very important for all children to attend school every day and to arrive on time.

Not only does lateness make a bad start to the day, **arrival after 9.30am is considered half a day's unauthorised absence.** All lateness/attendance is recorded and monitored by the school and the Education Welfare Officer.

School Uniform – PE Kits

Children in Nursery, Reception and Year One can come to school in their PE kit on the appropriate day. The PE uniform is:
