Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

Following advice from the DFE and Public Health England, all schools have been informed that they will be closed from the end of the day on Friday, 20th March 2020 for an indefinite period of time. Children are of course welcome to remain in school until that date.

As a school we have put in place measures for your child to complete school set work from home for the next couple of weeks. Other work will follow. Work available currently is as follows:

- Literacy - Reading Eggs - Accompanying this letter is a log in and password for Reading Eggs. Children can access books and activities at their own level. For those children who have used Reading Eggs via the school before, please note that we have reset all work. Work completed at home can be seen by the class teacher remotely.
- Literacy – Daily Reading – We expect children to be reading for at least half an hour everyday as they would be for guided reading sessions. If you are stuck for book ideas, there are suggested reading lists on every year group page on the website.
- Literacy – Writing – Keep a daily journal to ensure that your writing remains fluent. Remember to use sophisticated vocabulary, a range of sentences and exciting adverbial phrases. You can write the journal as yourself or as a book character from your favourite book.
- Literacy – Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar – Workbooks used in class throughout this academic year accompanies this letter. Pages to be completed during the closure have been noted.
- Literacy – Spelling – At the start of the summer term we will be holding our annual Spelling Bee. Lists of words accompany this letter so that children can start learning them now.
- Mathematics – Mathletics - Accompanying this letter is a log in and password for Mathletics. Work has been set which needs to be completed before school recommences. This work can be seen by the class teacher remotely. Children can also complete additional activities if they choose.
- Science – Accompanying this letter is a workbook based on our current science topic. Children should aim to complete this before returning to school.
- Coding – Children across the school are familiar with coding activities designed by Max Wainwright and used in class coding lessons. Go to www.newend.net then log in as "New End" to see the different activities.

- Art – A sketchbook has been provided as well as a drawing pencil. Other art materials can be used if available at home as well. Children are to complete sketches every school day to create their own portfolio. They may like to sketch the view from their window, set up their own still life or draw portraits of family members.
- Topic Project – In addition, children are encouraged to complete their own autobiography about their life so far. The autobiography can be completed on computer / devices or on paper. You might like to include key events (birth, siblings, proud moments, family members, holidays, first day at school, achievements, etc), goals and future ambitions, photos, information about hobbies, family tree, and what you might be doing in ten years time.

If your child does not have access to stationery items such as a ruler, pencil sharpener, coloured pencils, there are sets available to collect at the school office.

Thank you to the NESAs trustees who agreed to fund Athletics / Mathseeds, workbooks going home and stationery items for those who require it.

During the closure you may have questions or need clarity.

A response will be provide as quickly as possible but please remember that the school is still required to uphold GDPR principles so will not be sharing information relating to other children or families. I will continue to update parents via the school app and email for whole school issues.
