



EYFS and KS1 Phonics and Reading Schemes

At New End we teach phonics using the Letters and Sounds scheme of work. Phonics teaching starts in the Nursery and continues until the children are secure in applying their skills in reading and writing. Daily lessons focus on consolidating and developing the bank of phonics knowledge that the children need in order to read and write with confidence and fluency.

Reading is a key skill and we want children to have a love of books and become fluent and lifelong readers. We have a wide range of quality resources and texts to support children's reading. From Reception reading is taught every day through guided reading and story time is a key element of the day.

Every class has a set of CLPE Core Books appropriate for their age. Classes also use books from the following reading schemes:

- Phonic Bug
- Oxford Reading Tree
- Fireflies
